

DCS 3.3.0 ITR (informal)

5228	DCS – Deleting a file is slow

1. Deleting a file

- a. Prior to IT 3.3 being installed, delete rcc file from GUI and make note of the time it takes to delete the file by using the journal.
- b. Use the GUI to delete a file
 - i. Verify by using the journal the response time is better than in step a. The file is also physically deleted.
- c. Delete a file using command line mac_Delete
 - i. Verify by using the journal the response time is better than in step a. The file is also physically deleted.

Results:

Deleted a file with the previous version of DCS, the file took approximately 30 seconds as expected. Deleted that same file with the DCS 3.3 version and the file was deleted in less than 5 seconds.

2. Ingest CPF

- a. Ingest CPF L5CPF20090101_20090331.
 - i. Verify the CPF was ingested. A message will be displayed in the journal file.
- b. Ingest 2008 Quarter 1 CPF.
 - i. Verify the CPF was ingested. A message will be displayed in the journal file.
- c. Ingest several other CPFs.
 - i. Verify the CPF was ingested. A message will be displayed in the journal file.

Results:

Successfully ingested all of 2008 CPFs as well as 2009 Quarter 1 CPF.

3. Transfer CTS File

- a. Use the GUI to transfer a file from a CTS. Immediately after OK is clicked, try clicking OK again. Repeat and try clicking Cancel.
 - i. The GUI should not react to OK or Cancel being clicked again.

Results:

Transferred several files from CTS to DDS and attempting to click OK several times. Repeated with the Cancel button. The GUI did not crash.
